IPReg ABS (alternative business structures) – Licensing Consultation

As you may know, the IP Federation represents the views of a wide range of industries operating in the UK, Europe and internationally in intellectual property matters, both policy and practice, including patents and trade marks. Its members are listed at the end of this letter.

I understand that IPReg is holding a consultation on becoming a licensing authority for alternative business structures (ABS) with a closing date of 17 September 2012. Registered patent attorneys and trade mark attorneys working in industry are currently regulated by IPReg as individuals.

The attorneys working in industry are frequently employed by subsidiary companies and carry out work for the parent company and other subsidiaries, or, particularly in the case of UK-headquartered companies, are employed by the parent company and carry out work for the parent and subsidiary companies. Companies employing in-house attorneys do not want to become subject to the ABS regulations.

The IP Federation would appreciate confirmation that IPReg is not intending to include companies employing in-house attorneys within the ABS regulation. The Federation would appreciate being included in any consultation on the ABS regulation and offers to review the draft regulation to ensure in-house IP departments are not inadvertently included in the regulation.
